

# Old Roman Rite Ordo for July 2011

- ⊗ July 14 = † July 1, **Thur.**: Service of the octave of St. John the Baptist.
- ⊗ July 15 = † July 2, **Fri.**: Sts. Processus & Martinian.
- ⊗ July 16 = † July 3, **Sat.**: Service of St. Mary, comm. of Sts. Peter & Paul. At Vespers of St. Martin, comm. of 4th Sun. after Trinity and of the Trinity, and there is procession.
- ⊗ July 17 = † July 4, **Sun.**: St. Martin of Tours, comm. of 4th Sun. after Trinity.
- ⊗ July 18 = † July 5, **Mon.**: Service of the octave of Sts. Peter & Paul.
- ⊗ July 19 = † July 6, **Tue.**: Octave of Sts. Peter & Paul.
- ⊗ July 20 = † July 7, **Wed.**: Feria.
- ⊗ July 21 = † July 8, **Thur.**: Feria, or St. Kilian, m.
- ⊗ July 22 = † July 9, **Fri.**: St. Everilda, abs.
- ⊗ July 23 = † July 10, **Sat.**: Service of St. Mary. Comm. of the seven martyred brothers.
- ⊗ July 24 = † July 11, **Sun.**: Service of the 5th Sun. after Trinity, comm. of St. Benedict, ab.
- ⊗ July 25 = † July 12, **Mon.**: Feria, comm. of holy angels.
- ⊗ July 26 = † July 13, **Tue.**: Feria, comm. of the parish.
- ⊗ July 27 = † July 14, **Wed.**: Feria.
- ⊗ July 28 = † July 15, **Thur.**: St. Swithin, bp.
- ⊗ July 29 = † July 16, **Fri.**: Feria, comm. of the Cross.
- ⊗ July 30 = † July 17, **Sat.**: Service of St. Mary, comm. of St. Kenelm, m.
- ⊗ July 31 = † July 18, **Sun.**: 6th Sun. after Trinity, comm. of St. Arnulf, m.
- ⊗ Aug. 1 = † July 19, **Mon.**: Feria, comm. of the angels.
- ⊗ Aug. 2 = † July 20, **Tue.**: St. Margaret, v, m.
- ⊗ Aug. 3 = † July 21, **Wed.**: St. Praxedes, v.
- ⊗ Aug. 4 = † July 22, **Thur.**: St. Mary Magdalene.
- ⊗ Aug. 5 = † July 23, **Fri.**: Service of St. Mary, comm. of St. Apollinaris, b, m.
- ⊗ Aug. 6 = † July 24, **Sat.**: Office of St. Christina with ferial psalms, Mass of the vigil, & *abstinence*. At Vespers of St. James, comm. of Sts. Christopher & Cucuphas, of the 7th Sun. after Trinity, and of the Trinity, all without chant, and there is no procession.
- ⊗ Aug. 7 = † July 25, **Sun.**: Service of St. James, ap, comm. of Sts. Christopher & Cucuphas and of the 7th Sun. after Trinity. At Vespers of St. James, soft comm. of the 7th Sun. after Trinity, then sung comm. of St. Anne.
- ⊗ Aug. 8 = † July 26, **Mon.**: St. Anne, mother of St. Mary.
- ⊗ Aug. 9 = † July 27, **Tue.**: Seven Sleepers of Ephesus, mm.
- ⊗ Aug. 10 = † July 28, **Wed.**: St. Panteleimon, m, comm. of St. Sampson, bp.
- ⊗ Aug. 11 = † July 29, **Thur.**: Sts. Felix & others, mm.
- ⊗ Aug. 12 = † July 30, **Fri.**: Sts. Abdon & Sennen, mm.
- ⊗ Aug. 13 = † July 31, **Sat.**: Service of St. Mary, comm. of St. Herman, bp.

‘Feria’ means a plain weekday. ‘Comm.’ is ‘commemoration.’ ‘Service of St. Mary’ means her ‘Sat.’ office shown in the missal and office books. ‘M’ = martyr, ‘mm’ = martyrs, ‘ab’ = abbot, ‘abs’ = abbess, ‘bp’ = bishop, ‘ap’ = apostle, ‘v’ = virgin. Every Wed. and Fri. this month is a fast day. ‘Comm. of the parish’ means the Mass for one’s parishioners. This Ordo is according to Sarum use.
