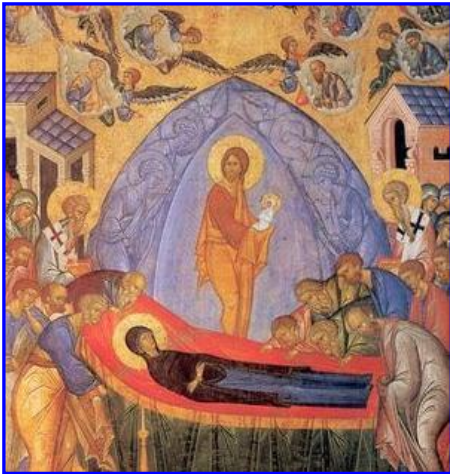

**Directions:** From Austin, head north on **I-35**. Take the Howard Lane exit (exit 246) and turn right (head east) on **Howard**. Cross Dessau Lane, then as the road curves south, turn left onto **Immanuel** Drive. Head

north on Immanuel. Pass Crystal Bend, before long turn left onto **Serenity**, then left onto **Celestial**, then right onto **Peridot**. We're on the corner of Peridot and Kodiak. The church sign will be easy to spot.
